Hello Early Start Service Providers,

Westside Regional Center is pleased to offer reimbursement for specific Early Start provider training. This is a one-time, time-limited supplemental grant which allocates funds to for Infants and Families, to help recover from the impacts of the pandemic.

More specifically, the Department of Developmental Services (DDS) has allocated funds to Westside Regional Center to reimburse early intervention service providers for 1) the cost of training fees and/or 2) staff time to attend training in the following three categories:

- Support the early intervention service provider in delivering effective and family-centered services that are responsive to the needs of the child and the family;
- 2. Promote acquisition of knowledge and skills in delivering culturally and linguistically sensitive services: and
- 3. Increase and retain workforce diversity.

Permissible training topics include the following:

- Cultural competency and cultural humility in the delivery of services
- Reflective practice and supervision
- Recognizing Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) and Toxic Stress
- Recognizing and addressing implicit bias in oneself, and in service delivery
- · Supporting early childhood inclusive practices

Online trainings are permissible regardless of the location of the trainer. Travel and lodging costs to attend trainings are not reimbursable.

Eligibility for Reimbursement

To be eligible for reimbursement, early intervention service providers and/or their staff must be serving a regional center consumer in the Early Start program and must be attending an approved training for a permissible topic as specified above.

Staff time reimbursement for attending training shall be the actual cost of time spent attending training, up to a maximum of \$50.00/hour, whichever is lower. The training must total at least one hour.

Requesting Funding from Regional Center

Early intervention service providers must submit a request for funding to the regional center at least 30 days before the scheduled training (Find the form attached). Providers will have 30 days to complete the approved training and will need to submit a verification of attendance to the regional center. The form will be emailed to you once your training request has been approved.

Funds will be made available to providers in the order training requests are received by the regional center. The final deadline for providers submitting training requests is September 30, 2023; however, this deadline is subject to close sooner based on the availability of funding.
