

### 2022 DDS Employment Grants for

## **Increasing Competitive Integrated Employment (CIE) Opportunities**

The Developmental Services Budget Trailer Bill, AB 136 (Chapter 76, Statutes of 2021), effective July 16, 2021, authorized additional funding to advance competitive integrated employment. Enacted as W&I Code Section 4870.1, DDS, received \$10 Million in funding to increase pathways to employment. The purpose of the grant program is to increase competitive integrated employment opportunities for individuals served by regional centers.

#### The 2022 Employment Grant priorities include:

- Implementing evidence-based, new, and emerging best practices for job attainment, retention, and career advancement through an individualized, self-directed, and whole person approach to services.
- Providing pathways to employment for individuals with high support needs through an individualized and whole person approach to services.
- Developing business or industry focused collaborations to increase workforce preparation and employment opportunities.
- Increasing family, adult and youth knowledge and use of community employment-related resources and services.
- Changing service delivery models to promote competitive integrated employment for all individuals served.

Through the Employment Grant opportunity, identified entities will develop and implement innovative and replicable strategies and practices to increase paid work experiences and employment opportunities for individuals who are served by regional centers.



#### ZAVIKON SUPPORTED PLACEMENT (ZSP)

Zavikon received a generous grant from the California Department of Developmental Services (DDS) to fund the ZSP program which subsidizes placement and support costs enabling Zavikon to extend its reach to a broader range of employers and departments.

ZSP services are free to job seekers.

#### **GETTING STARTED**



- 1. Contact Zavikon via one of the following methods:

- 2. Zavikon sends initial forms and schedules Meet & Greet
  - Initial forms to be completed in advance of Meet & Greet
  - Informal Meet & Greet typically lasts 30-45 minutes
- 3. Complete Zavikon forms
  - Additional forms sent after Meet & Greet
- 4. Once all forms are complete, Zavikon partners with you to strategize and match your career aspirations to job opportunities

#### SUPPORTED PLACEMENT

- When an opportunity has been identified, Zavikon supports both participant and employer through the following:
  - o Interview(s)
  - Onboarding
  - Acclimation (via 90 days of career coaching)
