Westside Regional Center (WRC) is seeking Subject Matter Experts in the fields of Mental Health and Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities (I/DD), Substance Use Prevention, as well as Motivational Interviewing (MI).

SUMMARY: WRC is looking for up to three (3) well-qualified subject matter experts in the fields of mental health and I/DD, substance use prevention, as well MI to develop training curricula for a series of e-learning courses (including instructional design/script writing). The subject matter experts must be experienced in:

- Working with individuals with I/DD and their circles of support,
- Developing and delivering culturally competent training curricula for service providers assisting individuals with I/DD,
- Utilizing evidence-based techniques to quip target audiences with skills in identification and understanding of substance abuse issues, trauma-informed care, Motivational Interviewing as well as provide tools to encourage and support population in treatment.

TARGET AUDIENCE: The primary target audience of this work will be regional center staff and vendored service providers working with individuals with intellectual/developmental disabilities dually diagnosed with mental health and substance use disorders.
